An interactive session on "Importance of Cyber Security in Modern Digital World" was organized by Department of Management, MBA, MAIT for MBA final year students (Batch 2020-22) on 12th November, 2021 at online platform.

Mr. Venkateswara Rao, Scientist 'E'/Additional Director, Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology was the guest speaker of the session.

The objective of the session was to guide the students about why cybersecurity has become important in the blink of an eye? How cybersecurity is attributed to increased reliance on technology, breaches and hacks of different companies, and rapid changes in technology that facilitated automated cyberattacks. Also, how cybersecurity in education is necessary to protect against financial loss and prevent disruption.

The session started with a welcome speech by the student coordinators, Ms. Tanya

Saxena & Ms. Shonima Jaswal (MBA, Final year). Mr. Venkateswara provided valuable insights on cyber security, cyber-attacks and different hygiene principles with the help of PowerPoint presentation.

Speaker started the talk by providing basic introduction about the role of CERT, what all activities are performed by it, such as incident response, incident prevention and security awareness along with security quality management services. Followed by risk associated with cyber space.

Mr Venkateswara further guided the students about the concept of social engineering which is done with the intensions of phishing, malware propagation and Nigerian (419) scams. He explained different types of frauds such as E frauds, UPI, QR Code etc., and how people with minimum knowledge can protect themselves from cyberattacks.

The various queries from students were handled by Mr. Venkateswara with proper explanations. The students were satisfied by the information provided by the speaker on cyber security and prevention against crimes associated with the same.

After the Webinar, the students got acquainted with the importance of cyber security is in the digital world and also understand the fact that management in modern day world is incomplete without safe use of technology and that too the cyber technology, which is touching every aspect of business and daily lives of citizens.

The session was attended by over 95 participants including faculty members of the department. The session was concluded by vote of thanks by Dr. Sanjeev Kumar.

It was an interesting and knowledgeable session that would certainly help students to face challenges in their professional lives and promote safer use of cyber tools and technologies.
