The course started on 1st November at 05:00 p.m. with a welcome speech by Prof. Dr. M.K. Bhat. The event took off with first day presentation by **Dr. Vishnuvajjala Aditya Srinivas**, Chief Operating Officer & Chief Economist at Bombay Stock Exchange Brokers Forum.

He explained about the regulatory role of Securities Exchange Board of India and different types of trading account as well as other basics of trading mechanism. He shared the mechanism of depository and its overall role in securities market in very interactive way.


On the second day of course Fundamental analysis of securities was covered. It helps the students to understand about undervalued and overvalued securities.

Risk-o-Meter and its importance

Six levels of risk for mutual fund schemes:

- i. Low Risk
- ii. Low to Moderate Risk
- iii. Moderate Risk
- iv. Moderately High Risk
- v. High Risk and
- vi. Very High Risk

Importance of Risk-o-meter :

- Helps align risk that a fund carries with the risk profile of the investor.
- Equity as asset class: Volatile: High risk
- Debt as asset class: Stable: Low risk
- Hybrid: Moderate: Depends on allocation and concentration
